## ABOUT NEW HAMPSHIRE HIGHLANDS

New Hampshire Highlands is held at St. Methodios Faith and Heritage Center. It is close to Interstate 89, about 3 miles from the village of Contoocook, NH. The camp is located on Clement Pond, on 191 acres of land. There are hiking trails, basketball and volleyball courts, and a swimming beach.

- Standard accommodations are in single-sex dormitories, with mattresses on platform beds. Each cabin has its own bathroom facilities with flush toilets, hot showers, and electrical outlets. The retreat house has private and semi-private rooms with bath and linens provided.
