DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Eastern Vermont:

Take Interstate 91 north or south to Exit 15. Travel 200 yards on Lake Morey Road. Turn left on U.S. Route 5 north. Travel ½ mile to center of town. Town Hall is on the left, behind the bandstand.

From Southern N.H.:

Take Interstate 93 north to Interstate 89. Take Interstate 89 north to Interstate 91. Follow directions from eastern Vermont.

THE ROYAL ALBERT AND ERICA STRATHSPEY

Gary Apfel and Allegra Shumway

8 by 32 Bar Strathspey for 3 Couples in a 4-Couple Longwise Set

- 1-8** 1st couple lead down the middle and back (waving to other dancers in a genteel fashion). Finish back to back in middle of set, facing 1st corners.
- 9-10** 1st couple set to 1st corners, who set back.
- 11 - 12** 1st couple turn 1st corners two hands, pull back right shoulder, and “flip” to face 2nd corners.
- 13 - 14** 1st couple set to 2nd corners, who set back.
- 13 - 16** 1st couple turn 2nd corners two hands, pull back right shoulder, and “flip” to end in 2nd place on opposite sides.
- 17 - 28** 2nd, 1st, and 3rd couples dance three-couple rights and lefts.
- 29 - 32** 1st couple turn two hands 1 ½ times to end in 2nd place own sides.

Repeat, having passed a couple.

This dance was written in honor of Albert and Erica Pfister of Unity, New Hampshire, who enjoy a bit of good-natured fun while dancing, and who are gracious enough to accept as well as offer the same.
