

C facing C RR

- 1- 1c+2c circle4 L and back
- 9- 1c+2c RHA: LHA
- 17- 1M+2W & 1W+2M (= person opposite) turn RH, turn LH
- 25- 1c to 2c A&R; pass dancer opposite RSh to meet next couple

- 1-8 1s cross down to dance reels of 3 on opposite sides & end 1st place opposite sides
- 9-16 1s lead down & back crossing to end facing Ladies side (1M behind 1L)
- 17-24 1s dance Tandem reel of 3 across with 2s (RSh to 2L). 1s end in middle at top with 2s stepping in behind them ready for ...
- 25-32 1s+2s dance Allemande

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3 LITTLE STAR S32 · 2/4L


- 1-4 1st man and 2nd woman set advancing, turn with both hands and return to place.
- 5-8 1st woman and 2nd man repeat bars 1-4.
- 9-16 1st couple cross giving right hands,
 - cast off one place as 2nd couple step up, and dance a half figure of eight around 2nd couple.
- **17–24** 2nd and 1st couples dance a diamond poussette.
- 25–32 2nd and 1st couples set to partner, turn with both hands once round and merge into a circle four hands round to the left.

Repeat having passed a couple.

- 1- 1c cross RH | cast off (2c up) ; ½Fig8 round 2c (2,1,3)
- 9- All lead down the middle and up, finish in centre
- **17–** 2c+1c+3c promenade (2,1,3)
- 25- Teapots R and L (2c+1W & 1M+3c RHA; LHA at other end)



5 THE CAMP OF PLEASURE

RSCDS XV 4 · Crib: E-cribs · Diagram: Keith Rose's Diagrams

- 1c turn RH; 1M+2W LH turn to finish in middle in 2pl (2M dances up to meet 1W)
- 9-2M+1W & 1M+2W Allemande
- 1c followed by 2c (2M starts upwards) 17lead down the middle; and up (2c leading)
- 2c+1c R&L 25-

- 1c down the middle {3} and up | cast off (2c up)
- 9-Reels3 across, 1c Rsh to 2cnr, finish facing 1cnr
- 17-Turn CPCP
- 25-Circle6 and back



- 1c turn RH | cast off (2c up); cross RH | cast R to finish 1W between 2c facing 1M between 3c
- 9-1c set to P I turn RH to finish between cnrs; set | turn RH to face 1cnr
- 17-Set to and turn corners
- 1c Lsh Reels3(6) with corners | cross to (2,1,3) 25-



- 1c lead down, cross and cast round 3c to 3plx (2c+3c up); 2c repeat (3c+1c up) (3,1x,2x)
- 9-3c repeat (1c+2c up); 1c+2c+3c turn BH 1½ (1,2,3)
- BSCDS Book 14.4 17-1c lead down, cross, cast round 3c, lead up to the top, cross and cast to 2pl (2c up) (2,1,3)
- 25-1c dance down between 3c and cast up to 2pl; 1c+2c+3c turn BH (2,1,3)



- 1- 1c+2c+3c Reels3 on opposite side, all crossing from the top, 2c starts out and up (1x,2x,3x)
- 9- 1c+2c+3c Reels3 on own sides, all crossing back from the top (1,2,3)



17- 1c set, cross RH, cast off (2c up); cross down LH between 3c and cast up (2,1,3)

25- 1c dance to top and cast off; all turn P RH (2,1,3)


- 1- 1c+2c Tourbillon
- 9- 2c+1c+3c mirror Reel3 on sides [1c in and down; join NH where appropriate; fin facing 1cnr]
- 17- 1c+1cnr pass & turn [1c pass R]; 1c+2cnr pass & turn [1c pass R to 2pl]
- **25** Circle6 and back

- 1- 1c cross RH | cast off two (2c+3c up); 3c+1c RHA
- 9- 1c lead to top, cross and cast to 2pl (3c down); 2c+1c LHA (2,1,3)
- 17-32 2c+3c ("corners") set and change place RH four times following the track of R&L (3M&2W make polite turns) while{16} 1c cross (across or up/dn) RH and cast R round the corner four times.



3C/4C longwise set.

Note by the deviser in TacTalk of jan. 1986: on [17-32] the corners set "as written"; they do not split the setting as is customary in "J.B. Milne".
